TENNIS PROGRAMME DELIVERY

The Wentworth tennis programme is structured to provide tennis playing opportunities for all ages and abilities (beginners through to team playing members). The focus is to ensure a balanced programme that provides coaching tuition (group and individual), social mix-ins, competitive tennis (team and friendly team) and member play opportunities.

TENNIS SESSIONS

Members can book courts for social use up to two weeks in advance at Reception (two hours at any one time). Call 01344 846366. Please **check-in** at Reception to claim your pre-booked court. Failure to check-in may result in your booking being taken by another member at Reception.

Members must play on booked courts. Failure to use the court within fifteen minutes of the booking time may result in loss of the booking and a re-let to another member.

A block of coaching sessions (more than two weeks) can be arranged through the Tennis department. Call 01344 846339.

Nine floodlit courts are available to book until 21.00 daily. Before commencing play, a member of the Tennis Team or the Duty Manager will ensure the lights are on.

A ball machine is available (April - October) for booking up to one hour at a time. The ball machine is free of charge and can be booked at Reception.

Racquet services include restringing, regripping and a hire service. Fees are payable direct to Tennis Professional Michael Cooper.

A 'try before you buy' retail service for racquets is available from the Tennis Professionals. Racquets can be purchased in the Professional Shop.

Tennis balls are available for purchase at Reception and the Professional Shop.

SOCIAL SESSIONS

Social sessions for various standards of play are available providing the opportunity to mix with other members for social play. A rotation system is used to organise play. Check weekly programme overleaf.

You are required to have an assessment from one of the Tennis Professionals before attending a social session.

CLUB TENNIS RATINGS

Wentworth Tennis & Health Club follow a simple ratings system which incorporates the snooker ball colours: Black (highest grade) / pink / blue / brown / green / yellow (lowest grade).

It is essential for a member to be graded in order to take part in the Club's programme of tennis activities.

All members are entitled to a ratings assessment. This will be a FOC 20 minute session with a Tennis Professional who will then brief the member on the sessions appropriate and available in the programme.

JUNIOR SOCIAL PLAY

For Juniors who are able to score and are of a full court playing standard. Approximately 10 years. Term time only.

TOURNAMENTS

The Club organises a variety of tournaments, competitions and championships throughout the year. For full details check the notice board. Wentworth Club enters a number of teams in local leagues for the competitive player.

TEAM TENNIS

Player selection is by invitation to team practice by the Tennis Professional/Team Captain. All team players are selected and then posted as a result of the Captains' team selection meetings prior to the commencement of each season.

TENNIS CLINICS/COURSES

Please see the notice boards for one-off fee paying clinics and courses for adults. Each clinic / course focuses on specific areas of the game.

COACHING

Coaching for groups and individuals is available for all ages and abilities.
